Writing Workshop

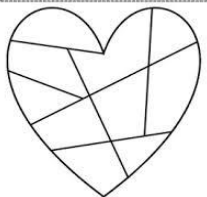


We'll take some time this week to write some cute "Love Lists" about all the people (and probably some pets) that we love.

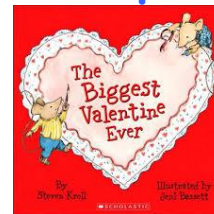
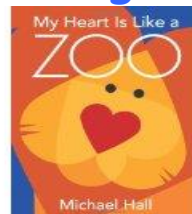
